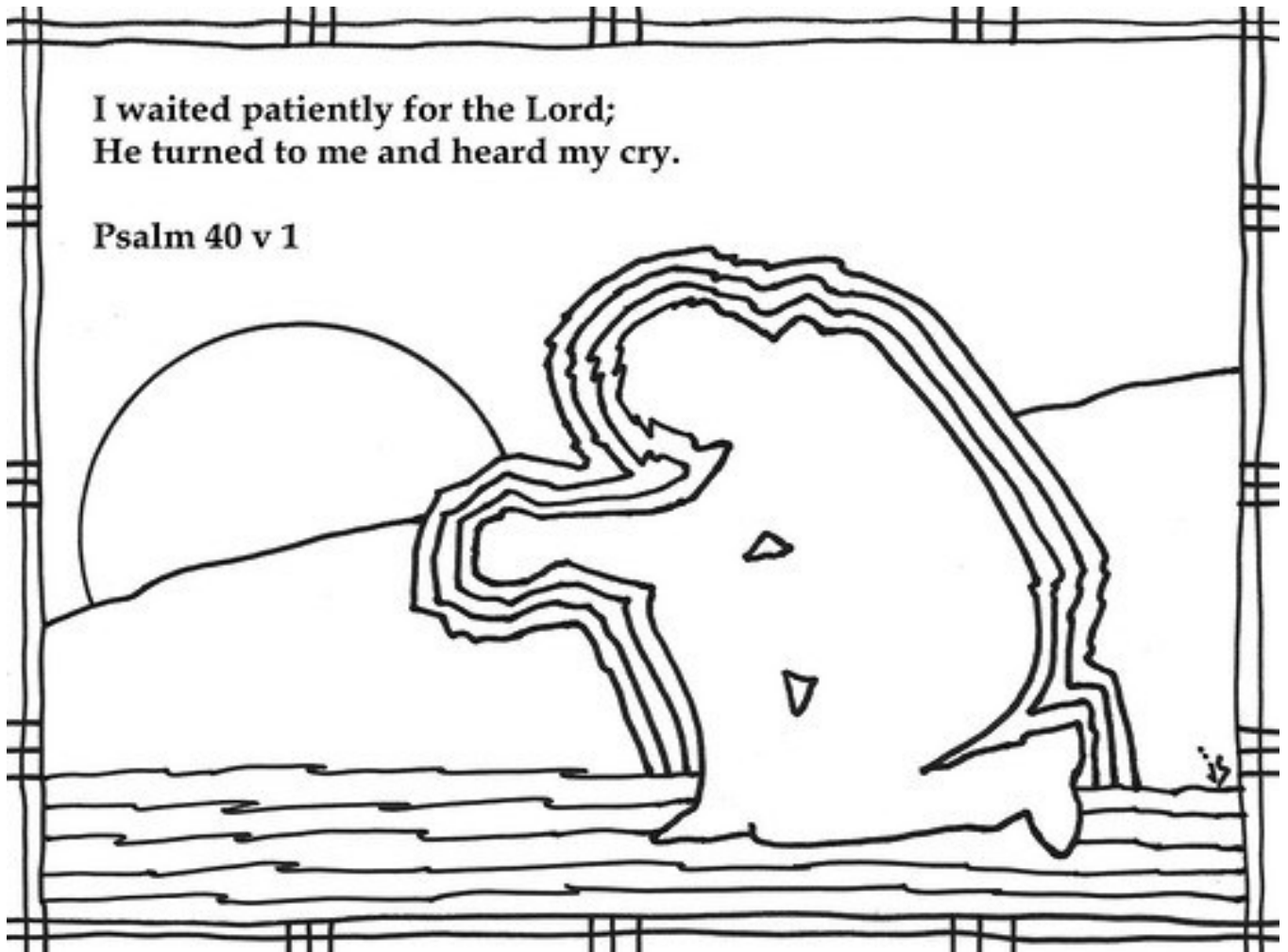
## Call to Worship - Psalm 40: 1 - 3

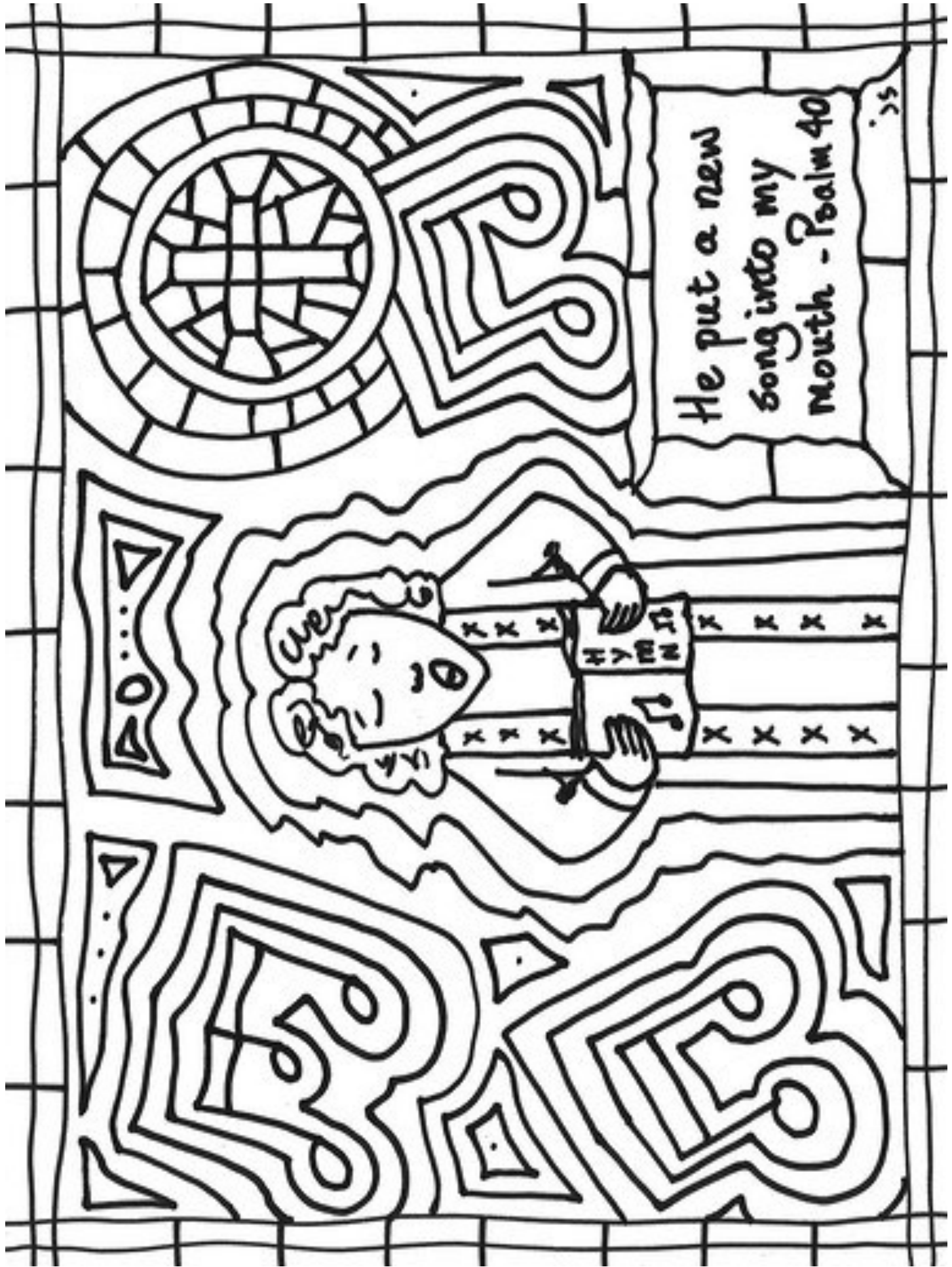
### **My Help and My Deliverer**

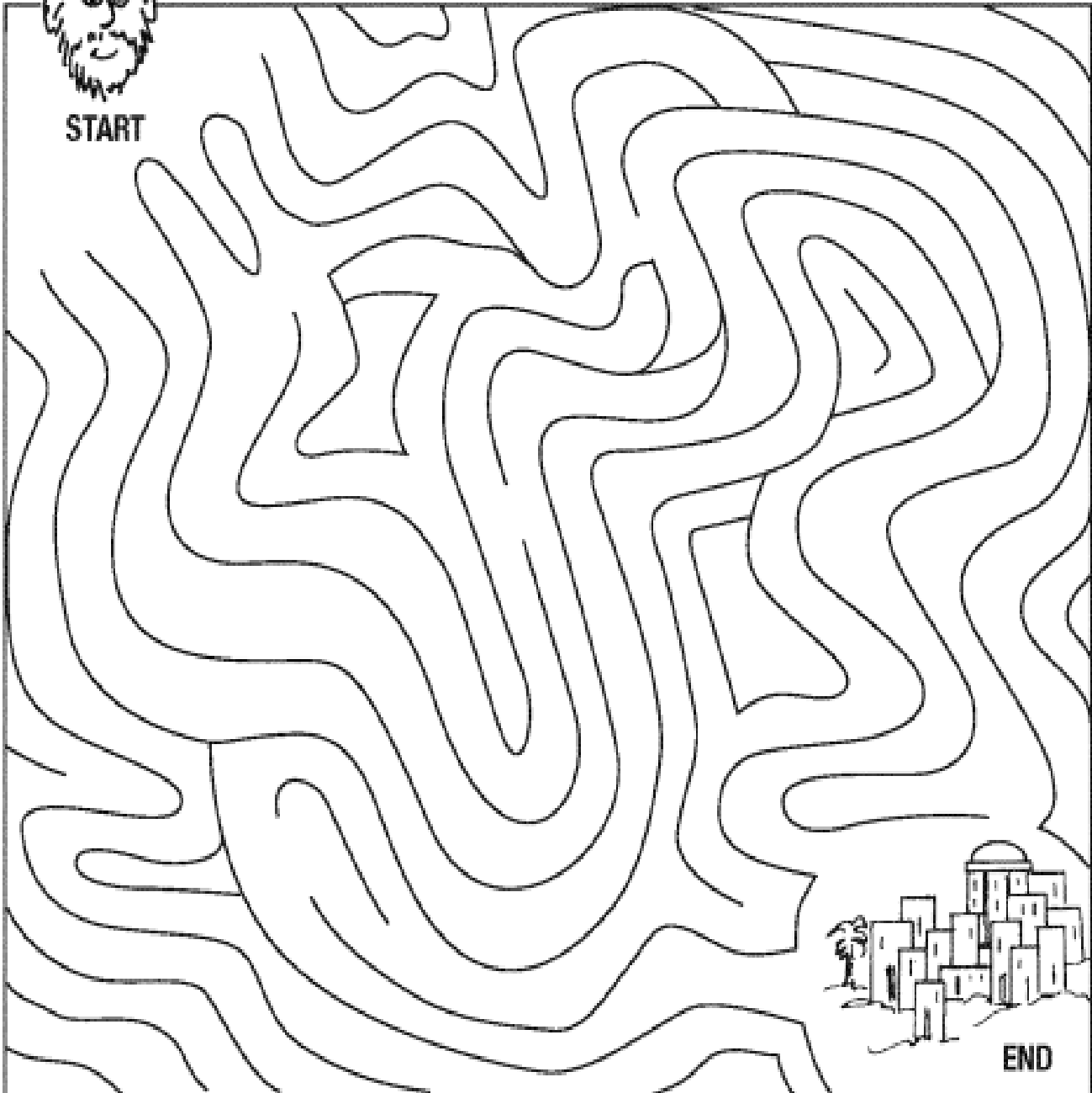
# Paul Preaches

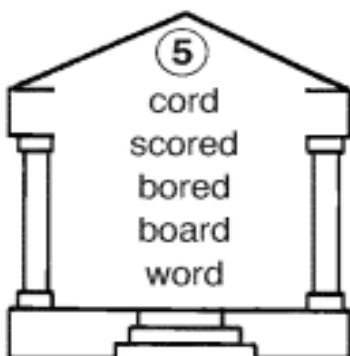


So Paul stayed in Corinth for a year and a half, teaching them the word of God.
