It is designed to offer children kindergarten through sixth grade, a fun, safe summer care experience. With social and peer interaction, day camp will have the components of academics, recreation and hands-on experiences for the children who are part of day camp.



## **Dates**

Summer day camp begins on Tuesday, May 30th. The last day of camp will be Friday, August 4. You will have ONE WEEK (of your choice) that you have the option of taking your child out of camp and not be required to pay. Please fill out a vacation form if you are going to exercise this option. With the exception of this optional week, each child MUST register for the entire summer.



There is a nonrefundable registration fee of \$75 for full-time and \$55 for part-time. Tuition is \$150 per week. (There are limited spots for daily enrollment at \$40 per day, with a minimum of 2 days) There is a

discounted rate to families who want to enroll a second child in the day camp program. There is NO REDUCTION of price for absences, with the exception of the one week. The first tuition payment must be made on or before the first day of camp. Online payments are available to you in addition to the Day Camp office. Each subsequent payment is expected on Monday of each week. Unless prior arrangements have been made with the director, a child will not be allowed to enter camp on Tuesday if payment has not been made for that week. If paying with cash, please place funds in an envelope with your child(ren)'s names on it and give to a camp staff member.



The camp is open from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM. A late fee of \$5 will be charged for every 5 minutes or fraction thereof that the child is in the camp after 5:30 PM. Field trips and special programs will not begin before 9:00 AM, and we will complete these activities by 4:00 PM.

# camp policies

- All enrollment forms must be completed and on file by May 30, 2024.
- Children who are ill are not to attend camp, see back for Illness Policy. If the child becomes ill during the day, parents will be called and the child should be picked up "within an hour of notification".
- If your child is to take any medication, including aspirin or children's pain reliever, you will need to fill out a medication form giving us permission to administer that medication. This form must be in your camper's folio by May 28. You must also provide us with the medication. It is preferred that the medication is unopened when given to us. If your child requires an inhaler or epi-pen, please provide one to remain with us at all times.
- Children should wear washable clothing in which they will be comfortable. Modest clothing is requested. Camp Tee Shirt and recreational shoes with socks are mandatory on field trip days. Closed toe shoes are preferred due to activities of the day.
- Snacks are provided in the morning and afternoon. Each child will be responsible for his or her lunch and drink. We have refrigeration and microwaves. (Limit use of the microwave to 3 minutes each.) Sack lunches only for field trip days.
- A security system is provided for the safety of your child. Pick-up and drop-off will be at the Salt House entrance, which is Parking Lot Two. This door will be locked. A staff member will meet you at the door for drop off and pick up. If for any reason you are picking them up early or in the case of emergency you may contact the church office at (615) 876-0527, and staff will be notified of your need.

#### Your child will Enjoy:

Your child will enjoy a fun-filled and creative schedule of exciting adventures that will be a summer to remember! Here are just a few of the highlights of the summer camp:

#### **Vacation Bible School**

At Breaker Rock Beach, kids will learn to recognize the difference between what the world says is true and what God says is true. They'll discover that God does not want them to be conformed to this age, but to be transformed by the renewing of their minds so that they can discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God (Romans 12:2).

#### summer Book club

Campers will be encouraged to pack a book each day and read as part of their daily routine. If the camper forgets, we will have books available to them.

The campers will be participating in community projects. This will include fun activities like making cards for Shut-ins, making treat bags for our first responders, and so much more. We want to teach the children that they can make a difference in their community no matter how old the are.

#### STEM Experience

We will offer activities to help your child to keep up their math & reading skills in a fun and creative ways. This will help them as they transition back to school in August.

## weekly Field Trips



# Sick Policy

For the protection of your child and the other children in our Day Camp, parents are not to bring a child to Camp who appears to be ill.

Children who have had the following symptoms within the last 24 hours will not be allowed to stay for camp:

- Fever 100.4 or above
- Vomiting or Diarrhea
- Green or cloudy runny nose Inflamed throat or mouth
- Runny or pink eyes
- Croup, coughing or sneezing
- Any skin infections such as boils
- Unexplained rash, staph, ringworms. or impetigo
